Project: Analysis of Monitoring Data

Description: The impetus for this study was a basic interest in determining how clean or polluted are stormwater discharges. Monitoring data collected from the late 1980s through the mid-1990s by municipal programs represented an opportunity to more clearly characterize stormwater from urban areas. The goal of the project was to compile existing stormwater monitoring data into a database and a user-friendly summary report. The database and summary report present the data, results of comparisons, pollutants of concern, and recommendations for changes to existing monitoring programs.
