Description: The purpose of the project was to develop BMPs that can improve the water quality and habitat values associated with the maintenance of flood control facilities in order to facilitate the acquisition of regulatory permits, including Clean Water Act (Sec. 401, 404, NPDES), Rivers and Harbors Act (Sec. 10), and State Fish and Game Code. The project involved searching for and compiling information on BMPs used for maintenance of flood control facilities. The collected information was used to develop guidance for flood control agencies on incorporating stormwater quality into maintenance activities.
