Project: Monitoring Protocol Standardization

Description: Alameda, Contra Costa, and Santa Clara counties conducted extensive stormwater runoff monitoring as a condition of their NPDES permits for a number of years. Each county and their contractors conducted sample collection and analyses independently. The intent of this project was to establish protocols for data collection from fixed stormwater monitoring stations, to ensure data are comparable from a quality assurance / quality control perspective, and to produce standard data transfer formats to allow centralization of the data to conduct comparisons. The final report makes recommendations for meeting these goals.
