- Project:** Regional Stormwater Monitoring Strategy
- Description:** Prior to 1997, although there had been some coordination of monitoring efforts through BASMAA, there had been no comprehensive development of a region-wide strategy or prioritization of special studies. In August 1996, the Regional Water Board requested a review and modification of current stormwater monitoring programs. The purpose of the project was to develop a region-wide stormwater monitoring strategy and implementation plan. The strategy outlines a monitoring program to measure the effectiveness of stormwater program efforts to reduce stormwater pollution. The implementation plan was meant to guide individual and collective monitoring projects during the next five years.
