Project: Dioxins Synthesis

Description: The purpose of this project was to develop an introduction to dioxins and furans for Bay Area stormwater managers and other interested parties. The emphasis is on issues related to urban runoff in the Bay Area, including regulatory context, impacts, sources, pathways, review of relevant Bay Area, national and international studies, and qualitative review of potential stormwater controls. The intent was not to perform an exhaustive review on these pollutants of concern, but rather to provide Bay Area stormwater managers with sufficient background to begin planning any future actions related to dioxins and furans.
