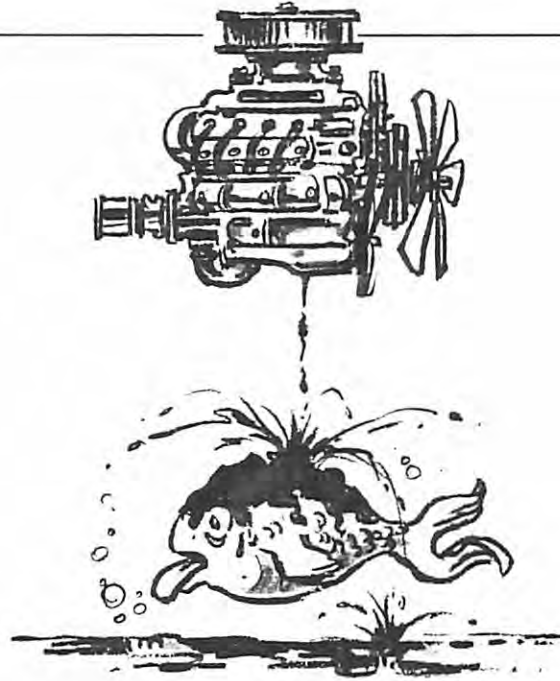


# HEY, DID YOU HEAR ABOUT THE FISH THAT DRANK A V-8?
