## Repository

The Bay Area Stormwater Management Agencies Association updated its website to serve as an archive of information about BASMAA and its projects and programs, as well as a [repository of work products](#) that may be viewed, downloaded, and borrowed. Over the course of three decades, BASMAA and its 103 member agencies initiated and conducted almost 150 projects and programs, including eight State and Federal grant projects, with a total cumulative budget of over \$25 million. Individual projects and programs ranged in size from \$500 to more than \$7 million and lasted for a few months to 20-plus years and counting for two programs. The website provides links to 1-3 page descriptions of each project and program and to more than 800 deliverables across the standard stormwater program elements (e.g., development, construction, monitoring, public information / participation). The vast majority of the deliverables are provided in PDF format for viewing and downloading while some outreach items are in mov, mp3, or mp4 format. Select outreach items are also in Spanish, Chinese, and Vietnamese. The deliverables can be categorized by the following project or program phases and include:

- Research - literature reviews; surveys and focus group reports; bibliographies; scoping studies; and issue / white papers.
- Planning and Design - conceptual approaches; strategies; work plans; study designs; sampling and analysis plans (SAPs); quality assurance project plans (QAPPs); standard operating procedures (SOPs); and quality assurance / quality control (QA/QC) tools.
- Implementation and Production - forms, templates, and checklists; databases; calculators; modeling analyses; criteria and specifications; design plans and typical details; contract and other model language; plan sheets; fact sheets; videos; badges, business cards, and certificates; labels, handouts, and signage; TV, radio, and print ads; and peer reviews.
- Reporting and Presenting - technical memos and updates; BMP and other guidance manuals; monitoring results and analyses; bioassessments; articles, branding, and fulfillment pieces; event fliers, agenda, and summaries; final and annual reports; press kits, contacts, and spokespersons lists; TV, radio, and print interviews; presentations; and training curricula and materials.
